### <u>SUMMARY</u>

On May 1, 2001, the Department of Defense (DoD) established a Family Subsistence Supplemental Allowance (FSSA) that will provide qualifying members and their families with a cash allowance of up to \$500 per month. This program was created to partially address the issue of enlisted members relying on food stamps to make ends meet.

#### **NEW POLICY**

- ➤ Benefits received under the FSSA program are countable as earned income for food stamps.
- ➤ The amount of the FSSA will appear on the individual's Leave and Earnings statement.

### PAYMENT ACCURACY

Carefully review the Leave and Earnings statement of members of the Armed Forces to check for this payment.

# **ACTION DUE**

The new policy is effective upon receipt with all new applications and recertifications.

## **CARES PROCEDURES**

- On the **ERN1** screen enter the appropriate information in the **Employer Name** field and **FS** in the **Type** field,
- On ERN2 screen enter the total gross pay from the Leave and Earnings statement making sure that the FSSA amount is included,
- Enter **WS** for verification,
- Enter AC in Freq field,
- Process case as usual.
