the bombs bursting in air,*

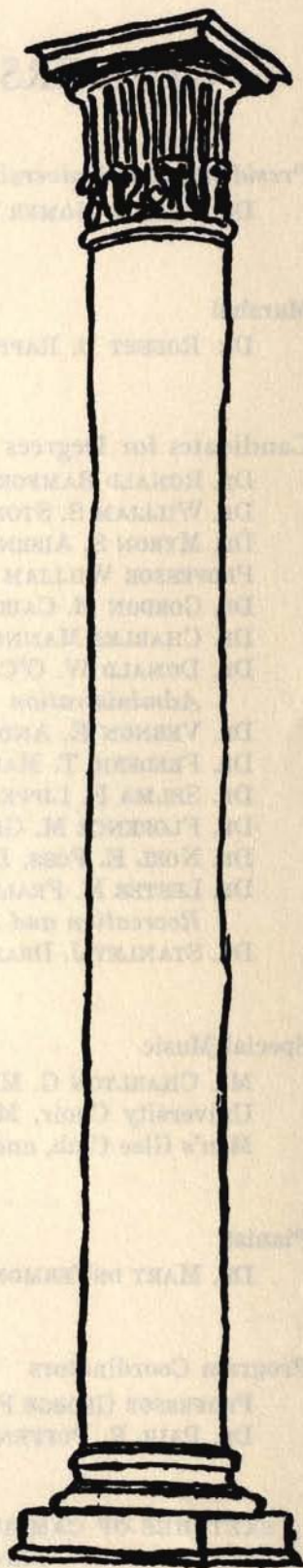
*Gave proof thro' the night

and the home of the brave?*

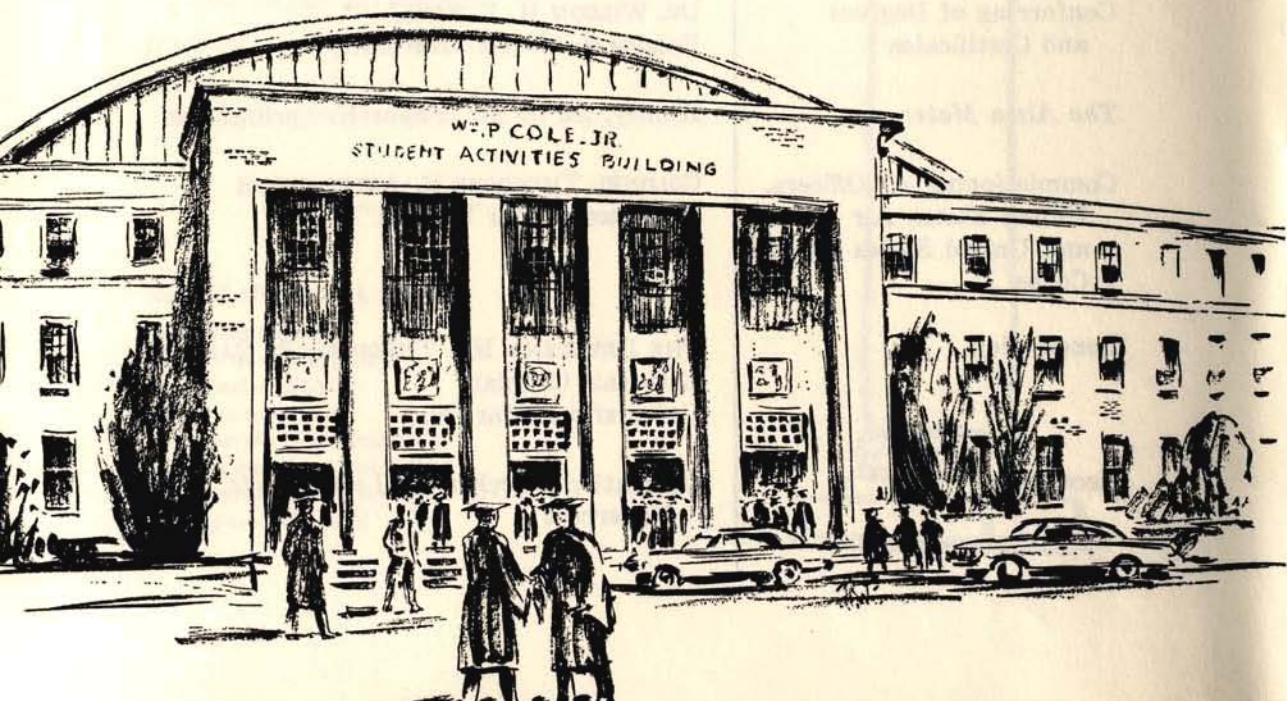

Honorary Degrees and Certificates

HONORARY DEGREES

LYNDON B. JOHNSON

Doctor of Laws

Lyndon B. Johnson has served as Vice President of the United States since he was administered the oath of that office on January 20, 1961. The Vice President was born on August 27, 1908, at Stonewall, Texas. The Bachelor of Science degree was conferred upon him in 1930 by the Southwest Texas Teachers College in San Marcos, and he attended Georgetown School of Law in Washington, D.C., in 1935. After teaching in the elementary and high grades in the public school system of Houston, he entered public life as secretary to Congressman "Dick" Kleberg of Texas, later he served as Director of the National Youth Administration in Texas. In 1937, he was elected to the Seventy-fifth Congress to fill an unexpired term. In 1948, after his sixth term in the House, Mr. Johnson was elected a United States Senator from Texas. He was reelected in 1954. In 1955, he was elected Majority Leader of the U. S. Senate, the youngest man to hold this position in either political party. At the 1960 Democratic Convention, Mr. Johnson was nominated for the Presidency of the United States, and received 409 votes. He was nominated for the Vice Presidency by acclamation. As Vice President, he has served as Chairman of the President's Committee on Equal Employment Opportunity, the National Aeronautics and Space Council, and the Peace Corps Advisory Council. He attends all meetings of the Security Council and the Cabinet.

HUNTINGTON CAIRNS

Doctor of Humane Letters

Dr. Huntington Cairns is Secretary, Treasurer and General Counsel of The National Gallery of Art. An alumnus and former member of the faculty of the University of Maryland, Dr. Cairns is a graduate of Baltimore City College, 1922. He received the degree Bachelor of Laws from the University of Maryland in 1925. He also holds the Doctor of Laws degree from New York University. He was awarded First Prize for his School of Law thesis, *Law of Charitable Trusts in Maryland* and was admitted to the Maryland Bar in 1926.

From 1935 to 1937, Dr. Cairns lectured in taxation at the University's School of Law. He served as Chairman of the radio program "An Invitation to Learning", 1940-41. In the years 1943 through 1946 he was Secretary of the American Commission for the Protection and Salvage of Artistic and Historic Monuments which operated in the war areas. He joined the National Gallery of Arts in 1943. Dr. Cairns is the author of several distinguished texts in the fine arts.

MORDECAI EZEKIEL

Doctor of Science

Dr. Mordecai Ezekiel is Chief of the United Nations Division, United States Agency for International Development. He was born on May 10, 1899 in Richmond, Virginia. He is an alumnus of the University of Maryland, having received the Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture in 1918. He was awarded the Master of Science degree in Agricultural Economics from the University of Minnesota and the Graduate School of the U. S. Department of Agriculture in 1923. The degree Doctor of Philosophy was conferred upon him in 1926 by the Robert Brookings Graduate School of Economics and Government. He was awarded a Guggenheim Fellowship for study in Europe in 1930.

Dr. Ezekiel's current mission is the development of maximum cooperation between American bilateral programs (AID) and all United Nations and U.N. specialized agency activities, to speed economic growth of less developed countries. He was a pioneer in the application of quantitative methods to problems of farm organization and production functions, analysis of supply-demand relations and methods of price forecasting. He is the author of major texts dealing with national and international problems in agricultural economics.

ARTHUR A. HOUGHTON, JR.

Doctor of Humane Letters

Arthur A. Houghton, Jr. is President of Steuben Glass, Incorporated. A patron of art and architecture, libraries and education, he was born in 1906 in Corning, New York, and was educated at St. Paul's School, Corncord, New Hampshire, and at Harvard University. Mr. Houghton is a Director of the Corning Glass Works and a Director and member of the Executive Committee of the U. S. Steel Corporation and the New York Life Insurance Company.

In the service of art and architecture, Mr. Houghton is Trustee of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Vice Chairman of the Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts, Inc.; Chairman of the New York Philharmonic, and Honorary Director and Life Member of the Society for the Preservation of Maryland Antiquities. He was Curator of Rare Books in the Library of Congress and Honorary Consultant in English Bibliography, 1940-42. He now serves as Vice President of the Pierpont Library and as Trustee of the New York Public Library.

In support of education, Mr. Houghton is Trustee of the Parsons School of Design, the Rockefeller Foundation, the Institute of International Education, the Modern Language Association, and the Educational Broadcasting Corporation. He was the recipient in 1960 of the Distinguished Service Award conferred by the University of Maryland. Mr. Houghton resides in New York City and at Wye Plantation, Queens-town, Maryland.

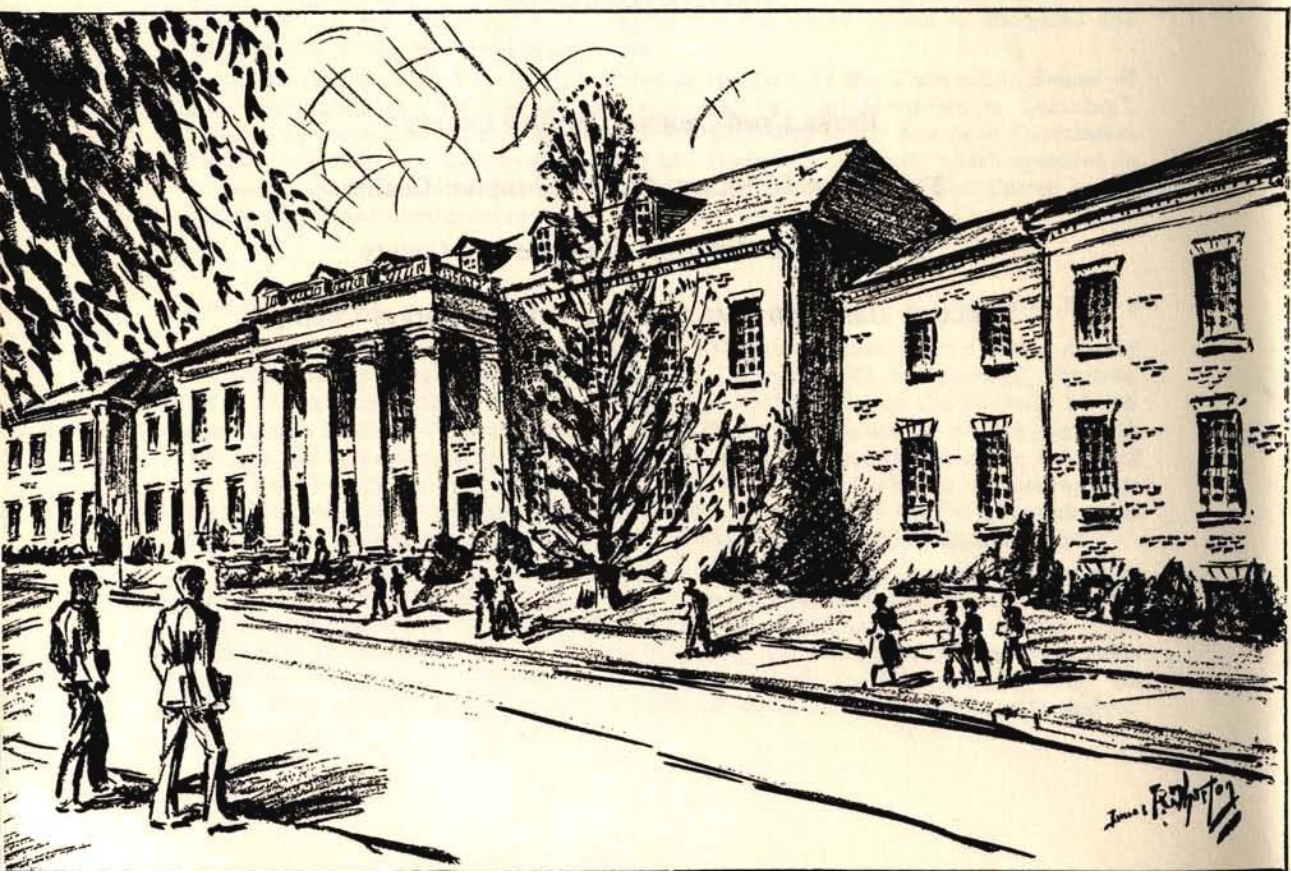
